Submit a typed overview of your proposed workshop that includes the following:

- * Title of workshop
- * Name, title and/or credentials of presenters, and organization
- * Address, phone number, and email for each presenter
- * Abstract of workshop (not to exceed 30 words) to be included in the conference brochure
- * A description of your target audience – people in recovery, professionals and other service providers, administrators, or others (specify). Note all that apply. This will be included in the brochure to assist persons to find workshops most relevant to their interests.
- * One page or less summary of the presentation with learning goals and objectives

You will need to be responsible for bringing all of your audiovisual needs. No AV equipment will be provided. Please bring a generous number of handouts for your session.

Preference will be given to workshops that are interactive, innovative, have consumer involvement, and have well defined goals.
